## **Gr 10 Parents/ Guardians**

An update about the upcoming assessments. All students in Grade 12 and Grade 10 must complete the BC Graduation assessments in the areas of **Numeracy and Literacy**. These assessments are prepared by the BC Ministry of Education and must be written by all students as a part of their graduation requirements. Due to the number of students, computer lab space and assessments, we've had to change some logistics to ensure all our students write their required assessments this school year, including students who might have missed it in the previous year, please see schedule below.

The Literacy 10 assessment is organized by registration of the student's Science 10 course. To ensure all our grade 10s write the Literacy 10 assessment, students will write the Literacy 10 assessment based on when they are taking their Science 10 course this school year. **Please see schedule below, grade 10 students who are taking Science 10 in SEMESTER 2 with either Mr Joe or Mr Gertz will be writing their Literacy 10 assessment on April 27<sup>th</sup> & 28<sup>th</sup>, 2022.** *Only students currently taking science 10 in Semester Two and Gr 11s & 12s who have not written, will be writing their Literacy 10 Assessment on April 27<sup>th</sup> or 28<sup>th</sup>.*

Students in Science 10 in semester 2, will also find out the exact date and time they are scheduled to write their Literacy 10 assessment via email, by speaking to their science 10 teacher and by checking the information page posted outside Student Services on April 11<sup>th</sup>.

**Gr 11 & 12 Parents/ Guardians**

Current grade 11 and 12 students who have not written the Literacy 10 assessment will also write in April 2022. Students can find out the exact date they are scheduled to write the Literacy 10 Assessment by checking the information page posted outside Student Services & Main Office on April 11<sup>th</sup> or connecting with their school counsellor.

Grade 12 students who have not written the Numeracy 10 assessment will write on April 28<sup>th</sup>, 2022 and Gr 11 students who have not written the Numeracy 10 assessment will complete in June, 2022.

**Instructions for Assessments on April 27<sup>th</sup> & 28<sup>th</sup>**

**ARRIVAL TIME:**

Time of Assessments: Please see schedule above, students will write their literacy 10 assessment based on schedule above. Students are asked to arrive for their assessment at ARRIVAL TIME. For example:

**Morning Assessments:** Please arrive at 8:45am, assessment will begin at 9am sharp.

**Afternoon Assessments:** Please arrive at 12:45pm, assessment will begin at 1pm sharp.

**ASSESSMENT TIME:**

The Literacy 10 Assessment is a 2-hour exam; however, students can receive an extra hour for a total of 3 hours. Students will receive one 1 piece of scrap paper to use during assessment. All scrap paper must be handed in to the teacher once student is finished.

**CELL PHONES, SMART WATCHES & BAGS:**

Upon entering, students should turn off their phones, AND smart watches all to be stored in their bags or lockers. All bags and coats will be put in the front of the room. Only pencils, pens and eraser should be on desk. NO FOOD OR WATER IS ALLOWED.

Cheating on an examination will result in a mark of zero.
