

Additional Language Requirements

- Some universities require specific language requirements
- For example
 - SFU
 - English Language Requirement: minimum of 3 years of study in English in Canada, or 6.5 IELTS/ 88 TOEFL

 - UBC
 - English Language Admission Requirements: minimum of 4 years of study in English in Canada, or 6.5 IELTS/ 90TOEFL
 - More information found at https://you.ubc.ca/applying-ubc/requirements/english-language-competency/
- Testing
 - <u>IELTS</u>: International English Language Testing System required if schooling has not been in an English-speaking environment for the last 3 or 4 years
 - TOEFL: generally required if schooling has not been in an English speaking environment for the last 3 or 4 years depending on institution

- You can register for any class that you are qualified to take with your ELL level and grade level (e.g., math classes, science classes, ELL classes)
- ELL summer school classes do not give credits towards graduation
- Grade 9 summer school classes do not give credits towards graduation
- Grade 10-12 summer school classes do give credits towards graduation
- Ask your counsellor for help with registering if you need it
