Welcome to Burnaby Central! Starting August 28<sup>th</sup>, Grade 8 students will be receiving a welcome phone call from a Burnaby Central student who is either a member of our Student Government or a member of one of our Leadership classes. Students will be calling from their personal devices, so their numbers will be blocked – so make sure you answer calls from an unlisted number that day if you'd like your reminder about starting your Grade 8 year a Burnaby Central. Every effort will be made by our Student Government members to contact each incoming Grade 8.

#### Tuesday, September 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2024

School opening is Tuesday, September 3<sup>rd</sup>. All Gr 8 students will be scheduled for a safety and school orientation to take place on September 3<sup>rd</sup> in the large gym at 12:30pm and will be dismissed at 3pm.

The Schedule for grade 8 students on opening day, Tuesday, Sept. 3<sup>rd</sup> is: 12:30pm – 3:00pm – Large Gym

- This orientation will cover the information for our school, explain our timetable, new bell schedule, flex time, locker instructions and student photo information, so that students arrive on September 3<sup>rd</sup> prepared to safely begin their classes. On Sept 3<sup>rd</sup>, students will receive their timetable schedule for the school year and instructions for their MyEDBC accounts in this orientation. Our gr 8 students will also enjoy activities lead by our leadership students and end the day with a BBQ lunch. We will be providing a barbecue hot dog lunch but ask that students bring a water bottle that can be refilled throughout the day. Other drinks will not be provided. Should this lunch not be suitable for your child, please be sure that they bring a packed lunch.

# What is Flexible Student Support Time?

## School Fees - School Cash Online System

All students pay a \$30 Student Activity Fee. This fee covers items such as Student ID Cards, and support for Student Government, clubs, intramurals and other activities.
