O365 Email Accounts & MyEducation

All Burnaby Central students have an Office 365 email account that can be accessed through the school website. This email address is the safest and most reliable method for Burnaby Central staff to communicate with students, and students are asked to check their Office 365 email account regularly. Please note that third party email addresses (e.g. @gmail, @hotmail) are sometimes filtered out by the School District's firewall.

Students MUST log in to MyEducation and access their class schedule prior to coming to school on Tuesday, September 3^{rd.} Please be aware that the parent view does NOT provide complete information on your child's timetable, so it is essential that your child log into their own account to access this information. What is Flexible Student Support Time?

• Working with students to support student learning.

• Personalized non-enrolling instructional time to support student learning choice and agency.

• Opportunity for group work/collaboration with peers.

• Time for linear learning support or enrichment – students can connect with their classroom teacher and other support personnel.

School Fees – School Cash Online System

All students pay a \$30 Student Activity Fee. This fee covers items such as Student ID Cards, and support for Student Government, clubs, intramurals and other activities. Yearbooks may be purchased for \$55. Students are encouraged to purchase the yearbook early as the cost will increase to \$65 after January 31, 2025.

To pay school fees, please use the Burnaby School District's secure online payment program, School Cash Online. Parents must register for School Cash Online program through <u>http://burnaby.schoolcashonline.com</u> or quick Links on Central's website at <u>http://central.burnabyschools.ca</u>. Once registered, you will be notified by email when any fees are available for payment. Please click <u>here</u> for instructions. <u>Student fees will also be collected starting on Wednesday</u>, September 4th.

School Supplies

Each teacher will inform his/her students about supply requirements for his/her specific course. Students should arrive at their first class on Sept 4th, with a binder and pen or pencil.

Student Timetables

Last year, students selected courses based on their interests, goals, and post-secondary plans, and we always do our best to make sure that students are enrolled in the courses of their choice.

As counsellors will be working on student timetables during the last week of August and first few days of September, the MyEducation portal will be opened **on the evening of Friday, August 30**th for students to access their schedules.

Course Change Requests

This year, we will be processing all change requests via office form which will be available August 30th at 3 pm on the school website/via email and the form closes Sept 6th. Students should fill out the office form to send any requests to the counsellor assigned to their last name. Students must attend all classes scheduled on their timetables (even if they are requesting an adjustment). Students should not assume that a course change can be made. Counsellors will do their best to honour the requests, but there are limitations based on what is available. Counsellors will call students from their scheduled classes to discuss requests, where spaces are available.

COUNSELLORS WILL NOT MAKE COURSE CHANGES UNLESS THERE IS A LEGITIMATE ERROR IN THEIR SCHEDULE TIMETABLE ERRORS INCLUDE THE FOLLOWING:

- You are missing a class (have fewer than 8 courses)
- You are scheduled in the wrong grade level of a course
- You are in a class that you have successfully completed
- You are missing a course that is required for Graduation or Post-Secondary Requirements
- You have an extremely unbalanced timetable (ex: 4 academics in one semester)

COUNSELLORS WILL NOT MAKE CHANGES IF ...

- You want a different teacher
- You don't like the time of day a class is offered
- Your friends are not in your class

Counsellors know this can be a stressful time for students, and they appreciate your patience.
