Cross District & Out of District Transfer

- ❑ If you do not live in our catchment area, you will need to complete a **Cross-District or Out-of-District Transfer application**
- ❑ Pick up an application form from your elementary school, at **Burnaby Central**, or on the school district website
- ❑ Submit the form to **Burnaby Central** by email or in-person prior to the deadline, **February 28th**
