

ACADEMIC HONOUR ROLL is determined by using final grades/proficiencies from Semesters 1 & 2. A student with a GPA of 3.0 or a Proficiency of 3.0 and above will receive honour roll recognition.

GPA equivalents: A=4.0; B=3.0; C+=2.5; C=2.0; C- =1.0; F=0

Proficiency Scale Equivalents: Extending= 4.0; Proficient= 3.0; Developing= 2.0; Emerging= 1.0; I.E.= 0.

Academic Honour Roll will be displayed throughout the school; no certificate will be printed

ATHLETE OF THE YEAR is awarded to a student who demonstrates athletic excellence in competition representing Burnaby Central Secondary. This student must display leadership, work ethic, passion and a strong commitment to the athletic program and school community.

ATHLETIC SERVICE AWARD is presented to a student who has demonstrated leadership by volunteering their time and providing a valuable service to the Athletic Department and our school community as a minor official, manager or student coach.

EXCELLENCE AWARD recognizes a student who has excelled in a curricular area. This student not only demonstrates academic rigor but also demonstrates: grit, leadership, punctuality, respectfulness, citizenship, team work, self-advocacy and social growth.

GOLD CORD is awarded to a student if they have achieved a GPA standing of 3.5 or higher in their course load in each of Grade 10, Grade 11 and Grade 12 (an average of 3.5 GPA or higher over the 3 years is not part of the calculation). The GPA calculations will be done for Grades 10 and 11 using Semester 1 and Semester 2 Final Grades. The GPA calculation for Grade 12 will be done using Semester 1 Final, and Term 3 Grades. Students will have completed a minimum of 7 courses at Burnaby Central in each school year OR an admin-approved academic course load. Please note Career Life Connections (CLC) 12 will be used in the calculation.

PRINCIPAL'S LIST acknowledges the accomplishments of students in each of grades 10,11, and 12. To qualify, a student must achieve all A's in their course load- while having completed a minimum of 7 courses at Burnaby Central OR an admin-approved academic course load. Semester 1 Final Grades and Term 3 Grades will be used in the calculation.
