As the School Leaving Ceremony is just under one month away, this is an exciting time for all graduates! CELEBRATIONS & INFORMATION

Dogwood

Information: Only 45 Grade 12s have completed the [following MANDATORY form](#) to ensure the office has accurate information to mail out your Dogwood once it arrives from the ministry. Please complete this ASAP.

Gold Cord Verification

The Preliminary Gold Cord List was posted prior to Spring Break. Students will be notified after Term 3 marks are finalized if they no longer qualify to receive a Gold Cord.

M365 Accounts

The Burnaby School District deactivates student M365 accounts once you graduate. They delete all Grade 12 accounts at maximum 30 days after the last day of the school year. Saying this, Grade 12 students need to ensure that they have saved any and all documents, emails, etc. from their school accounts before this time. There is no way to recover this information once the account has been deleted. Please ensure this is something you plan to complete in June.

As well, this year, our program will be available as a digital download 2 business days after the Ceremony- with a complimentary printed copy given to Graduates with the printed copy of their Crossing the Stage photo provided by Artona.

School Leaving Ceremony Rehearsal (MANDATORY):

This will take place at Burnaby Central in our Large Gym on Thursday, May 21st, 2026 in the large gym. Students will receive their grad caps & gowns, as well as their ceremony tickets.

GRADUATES: Need to be lined up for the processional in the AQ (Academic Quadrangle) no later than 12:15PM. Graduates who arrive late will not get to process in with the class and run the risk of not being included in the ceremony. It is recommended that Graduates wear comfortable shoes, as there is lots of walking to do during the Processional. Similarly, Graduates should not have bags or other personal belongings, as they will not necessarily be seated in the same chair from the start of the ceremony to its completion.

AUDIENCE: Parking is limited. Please arrive early. Seating is first come, first served. Arrive early to ensure you have a good seat. POST-SECONDARY PLANNING & GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS AND GRADE 12 REMINDERS

AP Exams

Reminder that students enrolled in an AP Course have their CollegeBoard Exams the first two weeks of May. Students will be excused by the AP Coordinator from classes that conflict with the writing of the exam ONLY; students are expected to be in their classes at all other times. Students have been sent an email with a form confirming they have completed installing Bluebook on their personal devices PRIOR to entering the examination space.

Career Life Connections 12 (CLC 12)

All grade 12 students graduating with a Dogwood Diploma must complete CLE 10, CLC 11 and CLC 12 to graduate. Ms Neves and Ms. Morabito are the CLC 12 advisors and can be reached via email, Teams or in person in A233. All Grade 12 students should have completed this requirement during Semester 1.

Core Competency

Additional Information: Assignments will be automatically loaded into student Microsoft 365 accounts. Be sure to check TEAMS for these mandatory assessment pieces.

Presentation

There will be a presentation for the graduation class of 2025. The date is Thursday May 21st, 2026 in the gym. *Attendance is mandatory.*

Numeracy & Literacy Assessments

The next opportunity to write any of the Provincial Assessments (Numeracy 10, Literacy 10 or Literacy 12) for Grade 12 students who have not completed this **Graduation Requirement** will be in June. A schedule will be created for those students who have yet to complete this graduation requirement; and communicated to them.

Scholarships & Bursaries

Available scholarships and bursaries will be posted on the Scholarship Team on Microsoft 365. Students should be actively looking and applying for scholarships now.
